## Instrumental Music Program - New Fees 2014

Please note the following new fees for instrumental music lessons in 2014.

TYPE	CHARGE PER SEMESTER Based on one lesson per week
INDIVIDUAL	\$600 (20 X \$30 lessons)
SHARED	\$300 (20 X \$15 lessons)
ENSEMBLE	\$100 (20 X \$5 rehearsals)
<b>TOTAL INDIVIDUAL</b>	\$700 Per Semester
<b>TOTAL SHARED</b>	\$400 Per Semester

The rise in lesson fees is due to an increase in the hourly rate as provided by the Victorian Instrumental Teachers Association.

All students having lessons are required to attend ensemble rehearsals and participate in performances. An ensemble fee of \$5 per week has been introduced to cover the cost of directing the rehearsal.
