It's another big boost to education for our community, after Richmond High School opened its doors earlier this year. It's catering for 650 students over two sites.

And it's all part of our \$353 million plan to build or plan schools in suburbs and towns all over Victoria.

The planning funding will go towards working out how the new campus can best serve students, teachers and local families – and we'll keep you updated every step of the way.
