

YEAR 10 PARENT PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS FOR 2021

Dear Parent, Guardian or Carer

Fitzroy High School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and we would like to advise you of the parent payment arrangements for 2021.

Fitzroy High School Council and its Finance Committee has worked closely with the Leadership Team and Business Manager to approve these arrangements in line with the revised Department of Education policy.

You will notice that the arrangements are categorised into Essential Student Learning Items (\$160), Voluntary Contributions (\$300) and Optional Items, such as music lessons.

We have made every effort to keep the cost of Essential Student Learning Items to a minimum and affordable for all parents. Many of these items are in place of a traditional booklist with textbooks.

We seek your support with respect to Voluntary Contributions, so that Fitzroy High School can maintain the high quality of education that we provide. These contributions will go towards providing additional materials, activities and services that enhance learning engagement and wellbeing outcomes for our students.

Your child will not be disadvantaged if you do not make a voluntary contribution. All records of voluntary contributions are kept confidential as well as your decision about whether to make a contribution or not.

Financial Support for Families

Fitzroy High School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund
- State Schools Relief Committee

Payment Methods

Several payment methods are available including direct deposit, BPay, in person or by phone or by Compass Parent Portal. Payment plans can be established on Compass using credit card and paid over ten monthly payments. Further details of payment methods and options are attached.

A pro rata refund of any payment will be provided where a student leaves the school during the year provided that the school has not incurred the cost of an item on behalf of the parent that is not refundable by a third party.

Direct Deposit – funds may be credited to our school bank account. It is essential that you include your **Family Code** (same as your Compass id) or **Student Name and** a brief description of what the payment is for e.g. “BAR0002 Essential Items”, “WIL0023 Year 7 Camp”, “Will Smith Essential Items” etc.

Bpay – Bpay codes are printed on your family statement. Bpay however does not allow for a description so it is suggested that you email accounts@fitzroyhs.vic.edu.au to advise that a Bpay payment has been made and what the payment is for, otherwise allocation is made to Essential Items.

In person or by phone - using cash, cheque or EFT including credit cards. Please bring this form when making payment.

Compass – Compass Course Confirmation allows you to pay online by credit card. Payment may be made in full or by establishing a payment plan of ten equal payments concluding on 5 September 2021.

The link to the payment is via Course Confirmation which is posted at the top right hand side of your Compass home page. See instructions over.

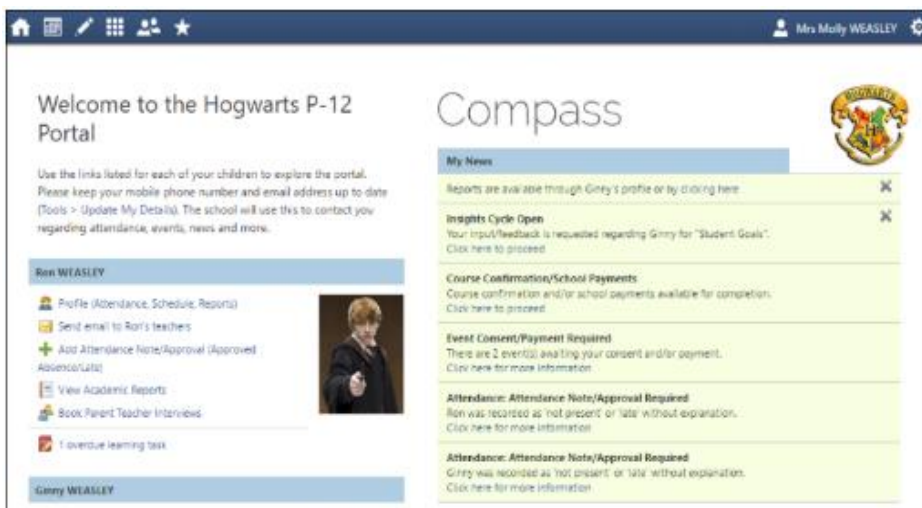
Compass – Course Confirmation/School Payments

Compass is an important communication tool that connects families to their child's school. Among the wide range of features that Compass offers, you can follow your child's academic progress, read school reports, consent and make payment for events, make approval for absences or notify future absences such as dental appointments, family holidays etc.

Your personal login details have been provided in the Information Pack. Students have a separate login and it is important that parents do not allow students to access the parent account.

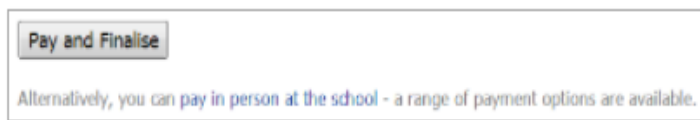
Fitzroy High School will post events such as course confirmation, camps and excursions for payment and consent. This is a very effective and convenient method of handling such processes and eliminates the handling of paperwork and cash.

A 'Course Confirmation' will be posted to your Compass Parent Portal later in October 2020 and can be found on your home page or "dashboard" as follows:



This enables you to make payment in full or to establish a payment plan of 10 x monthly instalments commencing on 15 December 2020 and continuing on the 5th day of each month until 5 September 2021.

To complete your course confirmation and to make payment or to set up a plan, please click on the link on your home page and follow all steps until the final payment page, where you will see this icon:



- click on **Pay and Finalise** to **make full payment** by credit card **OR** to establish a **payment plan**.

- click on the blue text – **pay in person at the school** – if you wish to print an invoice for payment at the school or by phone.

You may choose to pay for items such as optional extras and voluntary contributions in addition to the Essential Items.
